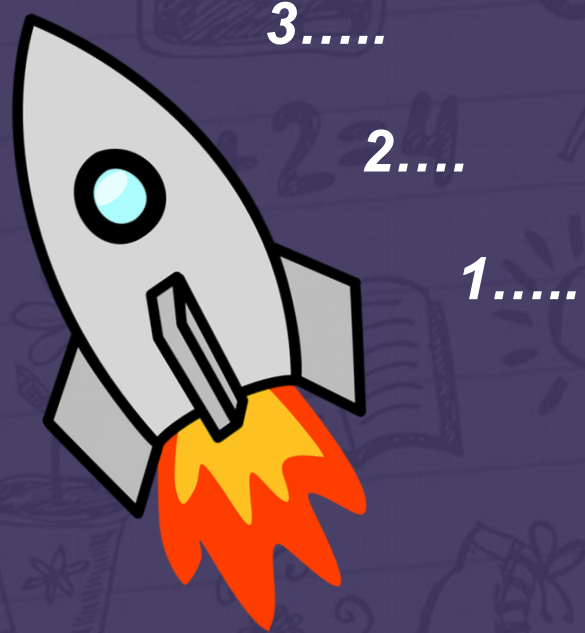
WELCOMING VICAR PHIL
