


# **Pastor's Peace**

"Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you." 1 Peter 5:6

As we continue our Lenten Journey, we are guided to the cross by Jesus who has called us to take up our crosses and follow Him. In taking up our crosses, we are not called to put ourselves on a cross but to acknowledge we are fully committed to Christ in our lives. When we take up our crosses, it is our call to bear one's cross as part of following Jesus, a call to be as submitted to Christ as the condemned criminal was to his death. This is how we follow Jesus; we realize it cannot be done alone and we submit ourselves to Christ as the one who conquers death and restores our right relationship.

During our journey together over the last 5 years, we have experienced growth, healing, and a willingness to try new things. This is a healthy journey and one we can be proud of as we continue to move through our lives together. A big step in this journey was the decision to partner with Bethel Lutheran Church in an effort to share resources and work collaboratively in spreading the Good News in our community. As with anything, there are growing pains and things needing to be tweaked along the way. Thus far, I would say that our partnership together has been fairly smooth sailing and I am grateful for the commitment to join together in worship, meals, and other significant events in the lives of our communities. One thing we sort of addressed when we began our life together was how offerings were going to be received when we visited each other's congregation for worship. We thought we had it planned out well, but there was a bit of confusion and questioning about how this was going to occur.

The Co-Council came together, worked through the issue with many thoughts, and came up with this solution. When visiting one another's churches any cash offerings would remain with the congregation we were present in for that day. Similarly, if you wanted to make an offering to the church we were worshipping in, that offering would remain there. Should you utilize a St. Paul's envelope or place a check in the offering for St. Paul's, I will ensure it makes its way back to St. Paul's for inclusion in our weekly offering. Obviously, Bethel LC will follow the same procedure. I am grateful for the number of you who attended Bethel LC for Sunday worship on February 18, 2024, and members of Bethel LC were glad you were able to join them. This will be the pattern we will follow for days in which I am not available for worship. We will continue to alternate worship locations which means the next joint worship will be at St. Paul's.

As has been highlighted in numerous forums, Bethel will be joining us for our weekly Lenten Worship services and have also been invited to join us for Soup and Sandwich. During Holy Week, we will be doing a joint worship on Maundy Thursday (March 28, 2024) at Bethel with Soup and Sandwich at 6pm in their Social Hall. There will be two opportunities for worship on Good Friday with a noon service at Bethel and 7pm service at St. Paul's. Worship times on Easter Sunday will remain as normal, yet we are being blessed with an Easter breakfast at 8am in the St. Paul's Social Hall.
