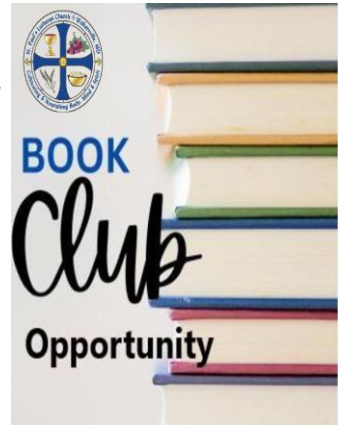

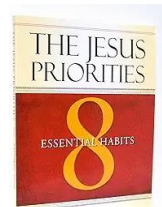


The eight priorities can be divided, like the Ten Commandments, into two primary categories.
